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Inherently Hazardous & Potentially Dangerous Event Release of Liability & Assumption of Risk Agreement

1. **NOTICE:** Your execution of this release agreement will prevent you, your heirs, administrators, assigns and legal representatives from recovering or bringing a claim against the Kelowna and District Safety Council Society, or any of its affiliated organizations, agents, employees (collectively the "KDSC"), or anyone in any way connected with your participation in KDSC's Motorcycle Training Program (the "Event").
2. **VOLUNTARY PARTICIPATION:** I acknowledge that I have voluntarily requested to participate in the Event.
3. **ACKNOWLEDGMENT AND ACCEPTANCE OF RISK:** I understand, acknowledge, and am aware that the Event is an inherently hazardous and potentially dangerous activity in which, as a participant, I may suffer serious bodily, psychological, physical and neurological injury or death, or cause injury to another's person or property. I am voluntarily participating in the Event with knowledge of the dangers involved and agree to accept any and all risks of damage, injury or death and verify the statement by initialing here:
4. **SUITABILITY OF PARTICIPANT:** I acknowledge that I should not participate in the Event if I am or will be under the influence of alcohol/drugs/medication during the Event, or have pre-existing physical limitations or conditions which may be aggravated or harmed by the Event.
5. **RELEASE AND HOLD HARMLESS:** As consideration for permission by KDSC to allow me to partake in the Event and use of its facilities, I hereby agree that I, my heirs, legal representatives, guardians and family will not make a claim against, sue or attach the property of KDSC for injury or damage to me resulting from the negligence or other acts, howsoever caused, by KDSC as a result of my participation in the Event. I further agree and forever hold harmless and indemnify KDSC from any and all negligence, injury or damages resulting in any way from my participation in the Event.
6. **KNOWING AND VOLUNTARY EXECUTION:** I have carefully read this contract and fully understand its content. I am aware this is a full release of liability and a contract between myself and KDSC, and I sign it of my own free will.
7. **PERSONAL BIKE:** When providing my own vehicle for training, I acknowledge and accept the risk of damage that might occur to it and undertake to hold KDSC harmless from any and all responsibility for any such damages, and the costs and expenses which might be involved in repair or replacement of my own vehicle as a result of such damages. I also verify that my vehicle is in a state of good mechanical repair and safe operating condition.
8. **REVOCATION MUST BE IN WRITING:** This document may not be revoked, amended, or altered by myself or KDSC without written consent from an authorized agent of KDSC.

Terms & Conditions

- Applications will be processed in the order in which they are received. Full payment must accompany all registrations. Requests for payment plans will be reviewed on a case by case basis, and are entirely at the discretion of KDSC.
- KDSC reserves the right to ask a student to leave the course if that student is intoxicated or behaving in a manner that puts the student or those around him/her at risk. Refunds will not be considered.
- Students who fail to bring their full Class 6 BC Driver's Licence to the course will be prevented from participating; refunds will not be considered.
- Students who fail to bring a safe motorcycle in good working condition to the course may be prevented from participating; refunds will not be considered. See ART Student Checklist for information on standards.
- Due to the progressive nature of the course, a student may be prevented from completing the course if he/she misses a day of instruction. Make-up lessons (\$125/4 hours) may be possible, but refunds will not be considered.
- In an effort to provide a healthy learning and working environment for our students and staff, smoking is not permitted during training. Students will be advised of designated smoking areas.
- KDSC reserves the right to charge a student for willful damage to KDSC property (e.g.: damage caused by intentional stunt riding or wheelies, or intentionally throwing a loaned helmet). No student will be charged for damage to KDSC property that results from normal wear and tear, or that occurs during the normal course of training.
- A fee of \$20.00 will be assessed for NSF cheques.
- Prices listed do not include applicable taxes.
- Credit Card payments over the phone constitute acceptance of KDSC's Terms/Conditions/Cancellation & Transfer Policies.

Cancellations & Transfers

- Cancellations made 15 calendar days or less prior to the start date of a course will not be refunded, regardless of when a student registered for the course.
- Cancellations made more than 15 calendar days prior to the start date of a course will be refunded less a \$75 fee.
- Transfers will be permitted at a cost of \$50, if the request is made in writing 15 or more calendar days prior to the start date of the course in which the student originally registered. Transfers will only be allowed within the same season.
- A student's chosen course dates are firm. Except within the bounds of the Cancellation & Transfer policies, students who do not attend their chosen dates will not be refunded or transferred to a later course. We strongly advise doing everything possible to attend your chosen course dates once you are within the 15 day "window" for cancellations or transfers.
- Extra Training, Private Training or Road Test Escorts cancelled with less than 48 hours' notice will be non-refundable. A \$15 admin fee will be assessed for sessions cancelled with more than 48 hours' notice.
- The "start date" of a course refers to the first date on which a student participates in any part of the Learn to Ride program.
- Requests for refunds and transfers must be made in writing. Please allow up to 3 weeks for refunds to be processed.

Gear Requirements

KDSC's gear standards are higher than those required by BC law, and students are responsible for ensuring that their gear meets KDSC's minimum standards. Any student who attends a training class with insufficient gear or without a valid Class 6/8 Learner's Permit or BCDL will not be permitted to participate. Refunds will not be considered. Free helmet, jacket, and glove loans are available, but must be pre-reserved. KDSC will not accept responsibility for students who do not pre-reserve gear rentals. Please contact KDSC prior to your course start, if you have any questions regarding your own gear. Courses run rain or shine. Rain gear is optional, but must be worn over approved gear, not instead of approved gear.

- **Helmet** - Must be a DOT approved, full face or modular flip-up, motorcycle-specific helmet. Half helmets, skull caps, toy, snowmobile, motocross, open face, or bicycle helmets are not acceptable.
- **Jacket** - Must be a motorcycle specific leather or textile jacket that zippers closed (button closures not permitted).
- **Pants** - The minimum acceptable standard for pants is sturdy denim jeans with no holes or tears. If chaps are worn, jeans must be worn under chaps. Cotton and corduroy are not permitted.
- **Gloves** - Must be leather or motorcycle specific textile gloves; no part of the fingers/hands/wrist may be exposed.
- **Boots** - Must be leather, covering the ankle completely, with low or no heels and a shallow forefoot area to facilitate gear shifting. Running shoes are not acceptable (even if they are high tops or made of soft leather). Sturdy leather/suede hiking boots are acceptable if they cover the ankle and are solid leather/suede. Although construction boots or cowboy boots meet these criteria, they may make controlling the bike more difficult due to height of toes and heels.

It is each student's responsibility to ensure that he/she meets the following minimum standards prior to participating in KDSC's Advanced Riding Techniques course. If unsure of the suitability of licenses, gear, or motorcycle, it is each student's responsibility to contact KDSC prior to the start of the course. Refunds will not be considered for students who arrive for training inadequately prepared to participate. This policy is in place to ensure the safety of students and instructing staff, as well as for legal reasons. Thank you for your understanding!

	License	Class 6 Driver's License.
	Registration	Proof of registration for the motorcycle to be used during training (must be brought to each day of the course).
	Insurance	Proof of motorcycle insurance to ICBC's current minimum on-road requirements (must be brought to each day of the course).
	KDSC Application Forms	Each student must complete and submit the following to KDSC: 1) ART Application Form 2) Liability Waiver.
✓	Gear	Minimum Standard
	Helmet, Jacket, Pants, Boots, Gloves	See Gear Requirements at bottom of Terms & Conditions Page. If students wish to borrow KDSC's gear, contact KDSC to reserve it as soon as possible to ensure availability.
✓	Motorcycle	Minimum Standard
	Tires	Front & rear treads must be above wear bar indicators.
	Brakes	Front & rear brakes must operate normally.
	Lights/Turn Signals	Working headlight, tail light, turn signals and brake light operated by both front and rear brake controls is required.
	Horn	Working horn.
	Mirrors	Motorcycle must be equipped with two mirrors.
